Allotment Rental Charges

Very sorry but the Parish Council have had to slightly increase the rental charges to take account of increased water charges and costs for repairs and maintenance to allotments.

From 1st April 2015 rental costs will be:

**Full Plot from £28 to £30
Plus £15 Water Charge**

**Half Plot from £14 to £15
Plus £7.50 Water Charge**

**Quarter Plot from £7 to
£7.50 Plus £3.75 Water**
